Dear Jennifer,

It is unfortunate that the City of Maywood City Council changed from its original intent to negotiate a long-term waste hauling agreement with Athens Services, offered in connection with Athens agreeing to take on the emergency services on behalf of the City.

As presented in Gary Clifford's letter to you dated February 13, 2020, Athens has incurred substantial costs and expenses to mobilize our operations to get Maywood cleaned up and provide the City outstanding service over the Thanksgiving holiday weekend and through the date of this letter. The company has accumulated and continues to incur costs associated with providing these services for the City. This includes billings to Maywood residents that have not been paid.

Enclosed is an invoice for these costs that needs to be paid by the City by Friday, February 21, 2020, or Athens will need to stop service immediately. We cannot continue to incur and accumulate these costs. Below are the bank wiring instructions for the City's use.
